This is the only building in Kaunas in advance devoted just to diplomatic representatives . The project made in 1930 by an architect Vytautas Landsbergis-Žemkalnis. The building is exceptional for functional planning of rooms, as an innovative solution of spaces of that time, peculiar to the most famous examples of modernistic architecture.
